## 2014 Be Bordô Sauvignon Blanc

Today, we're headed back to France for a wine from a winery that strives to have old world meet new world Bordeaux with its wine – Be Bordô. Its wines « offer a fresh take on the historic elegance of Bordeaux in a resolutely modern, direct, easy-drinking interpretation ». Here's the first wine we'll enjoy from this winery:

2014 Be Bordô Sauvignon Blanc bottled for BSD (Bordeaux, France).

This wine is mostly sauvignon blanc (85%) blended with a lesser amount of sémillon (15%). This wine comes in at 12% ABV. Here is the glass :



The wine showed a pale straw color. Apple, lemon, grapefruit, chalk and whiffs of peach all arrived on the nose. Apple, lemon, grapefruit, hay, chalk, wet river rock and hints of stone fruit followed on the crisp palate. The wine exhibited good acidity and minerality, along with average structure and length. This wine would make a good aperitif on a hot day and would pair well with freshly shucked oysters.

This wine has suggested retail price of \$11.99 and is distributed across the United States.
